# LINDAMOOD PHONEME SEQUENCING® PROGRAM (LiPS®)

The Lindamood Phoneme Sequencing® program\*, created by the late Patricia Lindamood, a speech pathologist, is a program which is designed to systematically teach students skills to decode words and to identify individual sounds and blends in words. Students focus on the articulatory features of consonant and vowel sounds and discover with their teacher that the sounds are not just heard, but seen and felt. They learn to label the sounds based on that information, and are then able to map the abstraction of letter on to the sound in order to develop sound/letter correspondences.

In this course, techniques of Precision Teaching, a system in which fluency is developed through short timings of content material, are applied to the LiPS® program. The trainer will be Patricia Pennington.

**Participants will:**

- Develop the ability to focus on the articulatory features and the sounds produced;
- Develop the ability to help students discover the consonant sounds and labels;
- Develop the ability to help students discover the vowel sounds and labels;
- Develop the ability to help students track patterns of single-syllable words and to make changes to patterns;
- Develop an understanding of the transition from single-syllable polysyllabic decoding;
- Develop the ability to apply techniques of Precision Teaching to aspect of the LiPS® program;
- Develop an understanding how the LiPS® program can be applied in remedial and regular classroom settings;
- Practice the various component parts of the LiPS® program with students.
